City councils in other cities: size, districts vs at-large, residents per district

Elected by district

New York City – 8.4 million population, 51 city council districts, four year terms, 165,000 residents per district

Los Angeles – 4 million population, 15 city council districts, four-year terms, 267,000 residents per district

Chicago – 2.7 million 50 city council districts (called aldermen), four-year terms, 54,000 residents per district

Phoenix – 1.6 million, city council of nine members, including the mayor elected at large, the other eight members elected by districts. 200,000 residents per district

San Antonio – 1.5 million 11 city council districts, including the mayor elected at large, the other ten members are elected by districts. 150,000 residents per district

San Diego – 1.4 million, 9 city council districts, 156,000 residents per district

Dallas – 1.33 million, 14 city council districts, 95,000 residents per district

San Jose – 1 million, 11 city council members including the mayor who is elected at-large, the other 10 members are elected by 10 districts. 100,000 residents per district

Austin – 951,000 city council with 10 districts. 95,000 per district

Fort Worth -- 874,401 9 city council members, including the mayor elected at large, with the other eight elected by districts 109,250 residents per district

City councils elected by a combo of districts and at-large:

Houston -2.3 million city council has 16 members. Five members are elected at large, while the other 11 are elected by districts. 209,000 residents per district

Philadelphia – 1.6 million city council has 17 members. Ten are elected by the city's ten districts and seven are elected at large. 160,000 residents per district

Charlotte, NC – 860,000 city council of 12 members, including the mayor. The mayor and four members are elected at large, the other seven members by districts. 123,000 residents per district

Atlanta -- 490,000 city council is made up of sixteen members. Twelve members are elected by districts, while three members and a council president are elected at large. 40,900 residents per district

Elected at-large

Columbus, OH -- 878,553 Council consists of seven members. Elections are held citywide.
